Your tour will begin on the Royal Route, where you will visit the Holy Cross Church with the urn containing the heart of Chopin. Then you will be driven to the Royal Lazienki Park where stands the famous monument dedicated to Fryderyk Chopin.

After visiting the sights in Warsaw, you will head to the birthplace of Fryderyk Chopin, a small manor house in **Zelazowa Wola**, 50 kilometers west of Warsaw. Chopin spent only the first seven months of his life there, but the place is worth visiting – this typical old Polish country house of the gentry has a cozy museum and a lovely park. On the way you will have an opportunity to enjoy the scenery of the Masovian countryside and stop in **Brochów** – its 16th century parish church witnessed Chopin's baptism and also the wedding ceremony of his parents in 1806.

If you need to broaden the knowledge with additional information, don't hesitate to visit the interactive **Chopin Museum in Warsaw**, located in old Ostrogski Palace, only a few steps from the city center. This interesting exhibition helps you understand the complicated classical music theory as well as the complicated biography of Chopin. You will not regret it!
