Auschwitz is situated at a distance of 230 km from Wroclaw which gives you approximately 3 hours ride in one way.

After arrival, the tour begins with a visit to the exhibitions inside some of the surviving prison blocks, the gas chamber and the crematorium. Afterwards, you'll head to the large wooden extermination camp at Auschwitz II - Birkenau. The guided tour finishes after 3,5 hours, then a private driver takes you back to your hotel in Wroclaw.
