The next stop is Gdynia - the leading Polish port with its sailing ship “Dar Pomorza” and battleship “Blyskawica”.

The mysterious image helped to make Czestochowa one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in the world - after Rome, Lourdes and Fatima. Our visit to the monastery includes the Miraculous Picture Chapel and the Basilica. You can also visit the 600th-Anniversary Museum, the Arsenal and the Treasury on your own.

Wroclaw is undoubtedly one of the most marvelous places in Poland.</p> <p>Wroclaw is situated on 12 islands, and by visiting the oldest part of the city you'll visit the most significant of them, Ostrow Tumski (the Cathedral Island). This is the place where St. John the Baptist's Cathedral and the two-storey Gothic Holy Cross Church were constructed in the 13th Century. We then continue our walk to the University, with its magnificent Baroque hall of Aula Leopoldina. The tour ends with a stroll around the Market Square, where you are bound to be amazed by the beauty of the Gothic City Hall.</p>
