

Upon arrival in Zakopane, the tour starts with a ride up the funicular railway to the top of **Mt. Gubalowka** where you get a marvelous view of the Tatra mountain range. After a stroll on the summit, we return down to visit the historical part of Zakopane with its old highlander cottages, surrounded by ash trees and blackened by the sun. These wooden houses and churches were built in the Zakopane style by the famous Polish artist, Stanislaw Ignacy Witkiewicz. You will also visit the famous cemetery in Peksowy Brzyzek and the wooden chapel in Jaszczurowka.

This is the place where St. John the Baptist's Cathedral and the two-storey Gothic Holy Cross Church were constructed in the 13th Century. We then continue our walk to the University, with its magnificent Baroque hall of Aula Leopoldina. The tour ends with a stroll around the Market Square, where you are bound to be amazed by the

beauty of the Gothic City Hall.
